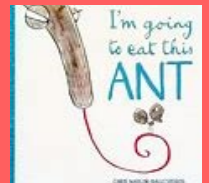
Rhyme of the week- **The grand old duke of York**

Word of the week- **Empty**



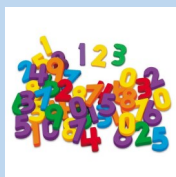
Literacy
